Qualifying for our rebates is easy. Simply follow these steps.

- 1. Check eligibility.** Your design must incorporate energy-efficiency measures beyond code in a new facility that results in a permanent reduction of electrical usage. Facilities must be served by Duke Energy Progress on a nonresidential rate.
- 2. Submit a pre-approval application.*** Pre-approval is required for all custom measures and technical assistance incentives, and is strongly recommended for all other projects. All forms are available on our website.
- 3. Complete the project.** Be sure that the equipment installed meets or exceeds the specifications that are detailed in our Policies and Procedures manual. See duke-energy.com/carolinasbusiness, and go to the how-to-qualify tab.
- 4. Submit final application.** Submit a final application as soon as possible upon project completion.
- 5. Receive your check.** Checks are usually sent six to eight weeks after final approval.

*A pre-approval application is not a guarantee of a rebate; the actual rebate will be based on the energy savings and equipment installed as determined in the final application. Funds will be reserved until the estimated completion date, unless the applicant is granted an extension. The program team reserves the right to contact the customer before the reservation expiration date to ensure that the project is moving forward. If the project is not under way, the reservation will be canceled. Funds that have been reserved are not transferable to other projects, facilities and/or customers. A waiting list may be established if funds become fully subscribed.
